From the HOA Board

Harbour Village HOA Member/Board meeting

The January meeting of the Harbour Village HOA Board of Directors took place on Tuesday, January 13, at The Lakes Clubhouse. Approximately 19 people were in attendance, with others attending via Zoom.

The Financial report was a repeat of last month's Financials. We are waiting for the End of Year Report from Kinney Management. This report will be available at next month's meeting.

In a Special Assessment update, it was shared that Roof Doctors, our independent roofing inspectors, will be providing a report of their findings in a week. Based on that report, the Five Guys Roofing Company will be expected to complete these repairs along with other repairs that have already been identified. The repairs need to be made before they are paid.

There are three bids that have been requested for repairing the tree damage in the South Parking Lot. When the bids have been received, decisions will be made on how they will be completed and paid for.

In new business, The Board is looking into acquiring a grant from the City of Tempe to address our water usage. Stay tuned for more on this topic.

Landscaping and Beautification Day:

The Board, with assistance from some owners, is working on developing an overarching landscape plan for Harbour Village. This plan includes more efficient irrigation, as well as tree and vegetation health and management in a changing climate. This will be a long-term project and will require careful planning and prioritizing the use of the HOAs limited operational budget.

At the moment, the HOA is working on a plan to address irrigation issues, which are resulting in inefficient water usage and high water bills.

A voluntary community Landscape Committee has also been established. The first activity they undertook was to walk the property to identify areas that require immediate and longer-term attention that can be incorporated into the landscape plan.

The Committee also launched **Harbour Village Beautification Days**. The next Beautification Day will take place on Sunday, January 25th, from 10AM-1PM. We will continue working on the maintenance and cleanup of vegetation around the property, finish sealcoating the back staircases of each building, and continue freshening up curb signage. Everyone is welcome!

Wear work clothes that you don't mind getting dirty. Bring gloves if you have them, a hat, and water. We'll have some coffee and snacks on hand, but in the spirit of reducing waste, please bring your own cup. Tools will be provided.
